## THIRD DISTRICT COUNTIES MEETING Monday, October 22th, 2014 Kalahari, Fall Convention

• **Treasurer's report** - accepted as read by Todd Giraud.

**Southern Zone VP— Jim Pickett:** reported that all items were discussed in the Convention General Business Sessions, no additional report.

**Speaker: Scott Stenger** - spoke on political action processes, the upcoming election and races throughout the state.

### COMMITTEE REPORTS

• **Membership Drive** – The list of Membership chairmen was updated. Monroe County reminded everyone to beware if their local governments were considering the Point System. Chris from Sport's Nut/LaCrosse reminded everyone of the importance of memberships and struggles with closing establishments.

• There was much discussion regarding some issues local leagues have experienced with the timeliness of the memberships reaching the TLW website, seeing that is the main tool local leagues use for recruitment and membership lists. It was recommended the best recourse was for the District Directors to address this at the State Board of Directors Meeting.

• **Nominations/Elections** – Tuna reported that the nomination process was discussed at the State Board meeting, and it was determined that the nominations would need to be repeated at this meeting. Jerry Day was nominated. Todd Giraud was nominated. Jim Pickett was nominated. Nominations are still open on the floor of the convention tomorrow (Thursday), then nominations will be closed.
